Mission

Membership

Membership in Chi Sigma Iota is by chapter invitation to both students and graduates of the chapters' counselor education programs. Students must have completed at least one semester of full-time graduate coursework (9 credit hours) in a counselor education degree program, have earned a grade point average of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 system, and be recommended for membership by the chapter, including promise for a capacity to represent the best about professional counseling through appropriate professional behavior, ethical judgment, emotional maturity, attitudes conducive to working to advocate for wellness and human dignity for all. Individuals receiving a letter of invitation to membership from their chapter may Member complete the online New Application.

Induction

Following the completion of the online New Member Application, CSI Headquarters will acknowledge receipt of the application and payment with a welcoming letter.
